Challenge

To take the visual concept created for the new shop in Loughborough, Leicestershire and manufacture all retail fixtures and fittings required. We were given 3 – 4 weeks from design to manufacture and delivery.

Solution

Our Engineering Manager sat down with Karen Bisby, Head of Retail at Rainbows and went through the store concept, what exactly was required and the specifications pertaining to the requirement, the timelines our client and her team were working to and, of course, the available budget.

Following that meeting our Engineering Manager produced all technical drawings which were submitted for our client’s approval. Once approval was given we went into the manufacturing stage.
